



SAIP Counsellor: Sexual Abuse Intervention Program (SAIP)
35 hours/week, full-time temporary – covering a maternity leave

SAIP provides professional counselling for young people under 19 years of age who have been or sexually abused, are exposed to the risk, or children under 12 with sexually problematic behaviours.

The SAIP Counsellor will:

- Provide ethical, professional clinical practice and support to child victims who have disclosed/suspect sexual abuse and support their families.
- Provide consultation and work corroboratively, where appropriate with other local agencies that provide services to young people dealing with sexual abuse
- Refer to other services when clients' needs are beyond the scope of this program.
- Advocate on a client's behalf when necessary.
- Maintain accurate reports and records on clients; ensure that all required documentation is complete.
- Compile computerized statistical data and report

Education, Training and Experience:

- A Masters level education in behavioural health discipline i.e. [psychology, counselling, clinical social work and/or related human service field]. Equivalencies may be considered.
- Specialized training and experience in evidence based sexual abuse.
- Proficient skills & experience in: screening & assessment, treatment planning, intervention individual & group, clinical consultation.
