

STOPPING THE VIOLENCE PROGRAM

Women's Counsellor (f/t)

Our Counsellors offer individual and group counselling for self-identified women, aged 19 and older, who have experienced relationship abuse, sexual assault, and/or physical, sexual, or emotional abuse at any age. Using a trauma-based approach, the Counsellors support women and offer a safe space for women to address issues that have arisen from their experiences. They will focus on empowering women to make decisions that feel right for them. This can include naming the type of abuse experienced, exploring and identifying coping strategies, strengths, and increasing a sense of safety in their lives

PEACE/ Women's Counsellor

In addition to offering counselling services to women (14 hrs. /wk.) our PEACE Counsellor (21 hr./wk.) provides individual and group counseling to children between the ages of 3-18 who have witnessed abuse, threats or violence in the home. Our PEACE Counsellor offers emotional and parenting support for the parents regarding the impact of witnessing violence on their children.

A post-secondary degree and 2 years related experience for both these positions is suggested, although other combinations of education and experience will be considered.
