The Sexual Assault Community Response Coordinator (SACRC) will be responsible for the strategic coordination of the agencies 'Community Based Response to Sexual Assault' project. This individual will collaborate and partner with Community Stakeholders to identify barriers to services, gaps in existing services, prioritize issues and develop strategies to provide a cohesive community-based response to sexual violence, and to increase education and awareness of sexual violence.
