

PEACE for Canadian Children & Youth:

Building Capacity and Fostering Connection in Nunavut Women's Shelters



April 2025

The BC Society of Transition Houses, in partnership with the Government of Nunavut's Department of Family Services and Women's Shelters Canada will be supporting Nunavut women's shelters with a two-year project to help build capacity and develop a community of practice among workers from different women's shelters. One of the main activities will be hosting annual Knowledge Sharing Gatherings for shelter staff in the fall of 2025 and again in the fall of 2026.

Shelters will receive an honorarium at the beginning of the project as a thanks for participating. Travel subsidies will also be available to help people attend the Knowledge Sharing Gatherings.

Workers who attended the PEACE for Canadian Children & Youth sessions in Iqaluit in 2023 and 2024 will be familiar with the training and mentorship offered at that time. This project will build on that work and hopes to support staff in ways they find useful. The project team are looking forward to meeting with people to find out more about how the project can help Nunavut women's shelters to do their essential 24/7 work.
